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CORE VALUE: DAILY QUESTIONS

These daily questions guide student leaders to actively embody our core values.

VALUE: START (Initiative)

A commitment to finding ways to be productive without being asked or told.

DAILY QUESTION:

What productive task did I do today without being asked or told?

VALUE: SPIRIT (Enthusiasm)

A commitment to having an optimistic mindset during obstacles and opportunities.

DAILY QUESTION:

What did I do today to bring a positive, enthusiastic, or encouraging vibe to those around me?

VALUE: SERVE (Work Ethic)

A commitment to go above and beyond what is required of me.

DAILY QUESTION:

What did I do today to exceed my own or others expectations of me?

VALUE: SHINE (Relationships)

A commitment to connecting with others in a meaningful way.

DAILY QUESTION:

What did I do today to strengthen my connection with others?

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CORE VALUE: START // INITIATIVE

The START Patch acknowledges that a student leader has mastered the skill of taking the INITIATIVE. Our program defines START as the student leader's ability to do something without being asked or told. To earn this patch student leader must complete each of the following four task:

- Create a New Activity/Event:** Develop a new activity or event using the 4P's Planning Document, submit for approval, and implement it.
- Lead an Existing Activity/Event:** Take the lead role in an already established event.
- One-on-One Meeting:** Schedule and attend a meeting with Mr. Aye to discuss personal leadership development.
- Lead a Class Session:** Lead a leadership development lesson or activity for the class.
